

Preview of oil products output from Exolum terminals to Spanish market*

April 2021

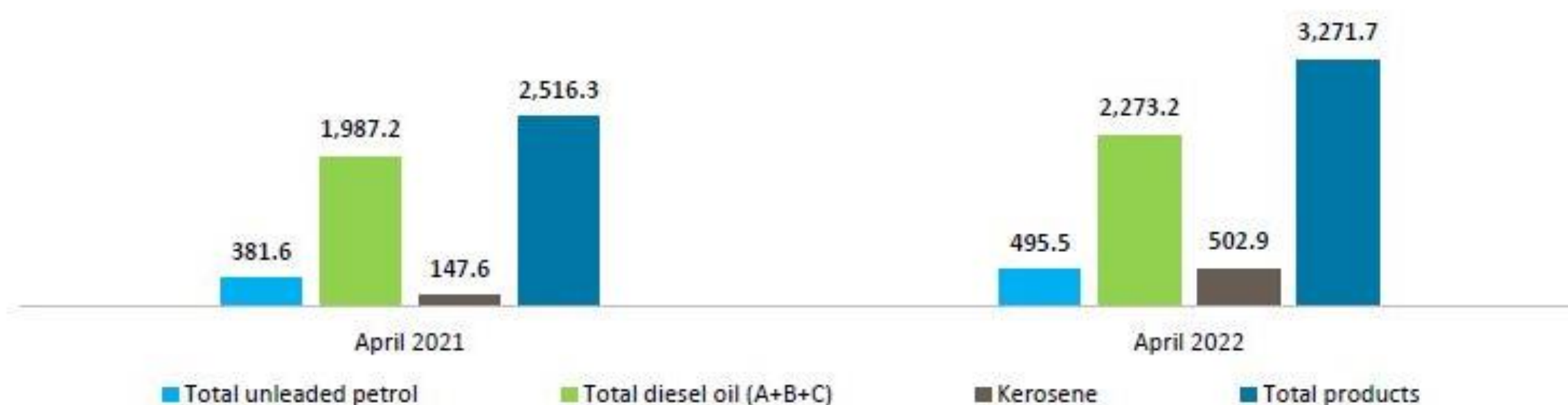
Deliveries of oil products from Exolum terminals to the Spanish market increased by 31.6% in April compared to the same period of the previous year.

Deliveries of oil products from Exolum terminals to the Spanish market during April reached 3.27 million cubic metres, 31.6% more than in the same period of the previous year, after correction of the seasonal effect.

Analysed by product type, deliveries of gasolines remained 30.8% more than in April 2021, and diesel fuel outflows were 18.4% higher than in the same period of 2021. Overall, motor fuel outflows reached 2.26 million cubic meters, standing 20.9% above their level in 2021.

Regarding the total for diesel fuels (automotive + off road + heating oil), deliveries amounted 2.27 million cubic metres, 16.7% less than in April 2021.

Lastly, deliveries of kerosenes exceeded 502,000 cubic metres, representing a increase of 239.3% compared with April of 2021.
