

Preview of oil products output from Exolum terminals to Spanish market* April 2023

Deliveries of oil products from Exolum terminals to the Spanish market increased by 0.1% in April compared to the same period of the previous year.


Deliveries of oil products from Exolum terminals to the Spanish market during April reached 3.2 million cubic metres, 0.1% more than in the same period of the previous year, after correction of the seasonal effect.

Analysed by product type, deliveries of gasolines remained 8.9% more than in April 2022, and diesel fuel outflows were 0,6% lower than in the same period of 2022. Overall, motor fuel outflows reached 2.2 million cubic meters, standing 1.3% over their level in 2022.

Regarding the total for diesel fuels (automotive + off road + heating oil), deliveries amounted 2.1 million cubic metres, 4.5% less than in April 2022.

Lastly, deliveries of kerosenes exceeded 563,800 cubic metres, representing an increase of 12% compared with April of 2022.
